BIOGRAPHY

Beatrice Sartori is a contemporary paper artist of Spanish, Italian, and Swiss origin, based in Switzerland.

A self-taught artist, she has passionately developed a distinctive practice of paper cutting and collage, where patience, precision, and imagination come together to create a poetic visual universe.

Her work has been exhibited in Switzerland and internationally, received several distinctions, and has been featured in art books and magazines.

In 2025, she represented Switzerland as Artist Ambassador at the prestigious exhibition Art Connects Women, held under the patronage of UNESCO.

Alongside her visual practice, Sartori is also an author of children's books and poetry.

ARTIST STATEMENT

My inspiration arises spontaneously from the elements around me, particularly from the shapes of paper scraps left behind by my cutting process.

Each artwork begins with a drawing, followed by the meticulous hand-cutting of every detail with scissors. Once the fragments are ready, I carefully assemble and layer them – sometimes up to eight layers – to create depth and relief.

My tools are simple: a pencil, scissors, tweezers, glue, and papers of varied textures and rich colors.

Exploring new graphic forms lies at the heart of my creative process: I compose shapes and thoughtfully select colors to express atmosphere and emotion. My work is characterized by a meticulous, graphic, colorful, and contemporary style.

I explore themes close to my heart: joy, peace, respect, and the essential bond between humanity and nature.

Committed to sustainability, I primarily use 100% recycled papers, aligning my artistic practice with respect for and preservation of the living world.

Through vibrant hues and layered textures, the figure becomes both festive and timeless.

A celebration of heritage and renewal, the work transforms remembrance into joy; a bridge between the living and the spirit of tradition



L'HOMME AUX OISEAUX

Paper cut collage | 50x50 cm | 2023

An abstract figure, eyes closed and arms open, welcomes birds that come to rest upon him.

A symbol of peace and communion with nature, this timeless scene illustrates harmony between humankind and the living world.

A work imbued with serenity and universality.



ENSEMBLE

Paper cut collage | 40x50 cm | 2026

A rhinoceros carries two small birds on its back.

In this shared presence, a gentle relationship of mutual support unfolds: by cleaning its skin and watching for danger, the birds contribute to its balance.

Through this quiet bond, the artwork evokes what truly matters: to exist together in a harmony, that makes us stronger.



AU RYTHME DE L'EAU

Paper cut collage | 40x50 cm | 2025

Three stylized waves carry bubbles inhabited by colorful fish.

Set against a clear sky, the sea evokes the fluidity of currents and the breath of life.

As a source of vitality, water nourishes, connects, and purifies.

This work pays tribute to its eternal cycle — to its quiet strength and power of renewal.



LEVER DE COULEURS

Paper cut collage | 40x50 cm | 2024

A radiant sunrise unfolds through layers of colored paper. From the glowing half-sphere, rays of green, yellow, and orange emerge, filled with butterflies and flowers.

The work celebrates light, renewal, and hope — a meditation on vitality and transformation, where color and form evoke the promise of a new beginning.



HORIZON

Paper cut collage | 50x40 cm | 2024

A glowing sunset ignites the sea, blending the brilliance of the sky with the shifting reflections of the waves. Through a delicate play of layered paper, light seems to dance upon the water.

In the distance, the majestic tail of a whale rises — a symbol of strength and mystery — while birds in flight evoke the vastness and freedom of the horizon.



FLORAISONS DE SOURIRES

Paper cut collage | 50x40 cm | 2025

Amid gentle green hills unfolds a field of flowers shaped like smiling mouths. Two orange butterflies rise into a clear blue sky, adding lightness and motion.

This whimsical composition celebrates the warmth and joy of nature — an invitation to connection and wonder.

The blooming smiles, both playful and unexpected, become a metaphor for shared happiness — a flourishing of joy that brightens the spirit.



LIBERTÉ

This painting depicts an orange-hued bird. Breaking free from all constraints, it emerges from the clouds, spreading its wide wings adorned with rainbow hues, symbolizing peace and hope.

The clouds, composed of successive layers of paper in shades of blue, mauve, and pink, evoke a horizon bathed in softness and light.

In its ascent toward an infinite azure sky, the bird embodies freedom.



UN MATIN NOUVEAU

At the top of a gentle hill, a colorful bird drinks from a drop of dew as an orange sun rises, bathing the scene in light. Warm reds and golds meet the freshness of dawn.

With closed eyes, the bird savors the moment — a symbol of renewal and inner calm, where hope and serenity awaken with the first light of day.



ÉVEIL

Against a vivid green backdrop, butterflies take flight — messengers of hope, freedom, and renewal. A poetic vision of life blossoming in unity with the natural world.



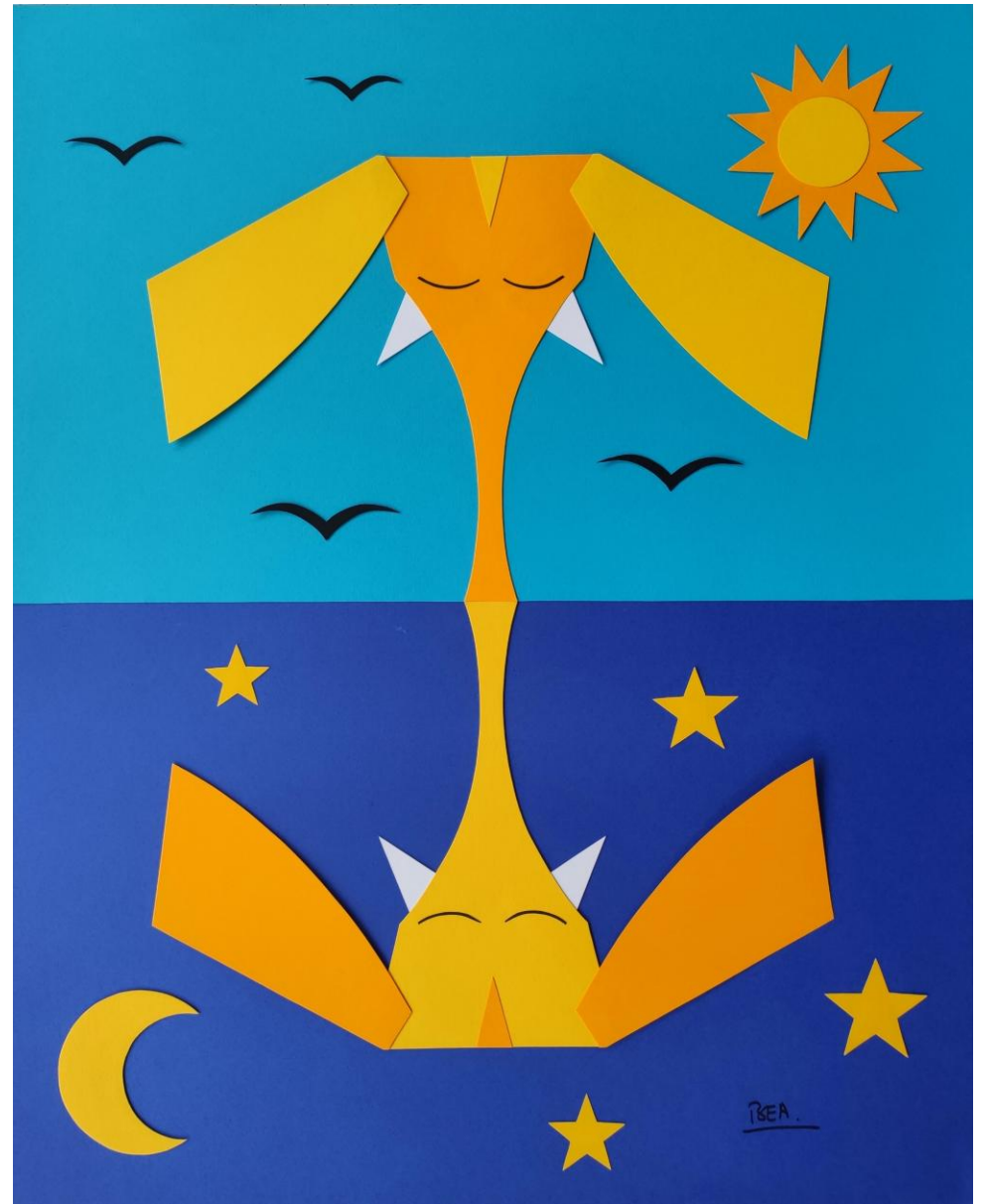
INTROSPECTION

Paper cut collage | 50x40 cm | 2024

In a star-filled sky, Gaia, the Earth's maternal figure, gently cradles the planet in her arms. Her sorrowful gaze reveals the fragility of all living things.
